COMES NOW the State of Iowa, by and through Denise A. Timmins, Assistant Attorney General, and for its Resistance to Defendant's Application for Furlough from Pretrial Supervision states:

1. Defendant's bond was reduced to \$50,000 cash or surety, and Defendant posted bond on October 5, 2017.

2. In its Pretrial Release Recommendation filed herein on September 28, 2017, the Eighth Judicial District Department of Correctional Services recommended Defendant not be considered for release to pretrial supervision.

3. The Defendant's wife and children reside in Ammon, Idaho, and the State feels Defendant may not return to the State of Iowa should he be allowed to return home to Idaho, even for a brief period of time. Defendant can make alternate arrangements to have his clothing and personal and work-related items sent to him.

4. The undersigned agrees that a hearing should be set and notifies the Court that she is beginning a trial in Greene County, Iowa, on October 17, 2017, which is anticipated to last through October 20, 2017.

WHEREFORE, the State respectfully requests this matter be set for hearing, and that said hearing be held telephonically.
