The State's "Motion to Preserve Testimony" came on for hearing during the pretrial conference on November 27, 2017. The Motion was filed November 17, 2017. On the record, Defendant consented to the Motion. Therefore, the Motion is granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED the deposition of the juvenile witness known as M.A. shall be taken by the attorneys the week of November 27, 2017. Defense counsel will initially depose the witness as a discovery deposition. Thereafter, an audio visual evidentiary deposition shall be taken of the witness with the State asking questions on direct examination, and defense counsel asking questions in cross-examination. The audio visual deposition will be preserved and displayed to the jury, during trial of this case, in lieu of the personal attendance at trial of the witness M.A.
